

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

All exhibits must be the original work of the exhibitor and must have been created in the last 12 months All exhibits must be for genuine sale with the exemptions of Primary/Secondary student's exhibits. All entry forms must be received or postmarked by Monday 28th January, 2018. **No late entries will be accepted.**

- Each work is eligible for one prize only, with the judges' decision being final. (Peoples choice award and Best Exhibit are exempt from this rule). Awards are non-acquisitive unless otherwise stated.
- Limit of 3 entries per person. If entering 3 exhibits one must be a small exhibit (max 20cmx20cm including frame or if 3D fit within 20cm cube).
- 2D ARTWORKS Unless suitably framed and securely wired for hanging entry will not be accepted. Maximum size accepted is 1.2mts in any direction including frame.
- 3D ARTWORKS must be able to be moved into and out of exhibition space by one person Maximum size accepted is 1.2M width by 2.2mtrs height. (Footprint no greater than 1.2M)
- Artist's name, Title of work and Price must be attached to the back or underside of each exhibit entered.
- The Committee reserves the right to use any artwork for promotional purposes.
- All reasonable care will be taken with artworks, but artists are responsible for their own insurance.
- All entries will be seen by the selection panel and will be hung at the organisers discretion, dependant upon space available.
- Finalists will be advised after the judging on the afternoon of Wednesday February 7th.
- The committee requests the attendance of finalists at the presentation night where possible.
- By entering you agree to the terms and conditions
